Partners in Evangelism, a partnership of The Word Among Us, Inc., its readers, and other donors, was established in response to a growing awareness of the need to support Catholics whose circumstances make it impossible for their home parishes to adequately minister to them. This partnership is one of prayer as well as financial support.

Partners in Evangelism raises funds to donate free copies of *The Word Among Us*—the daily devotional magazine based on the Mass readings—and other spiritual materials. Working together with our donors, Partners is offering God's love, compassion, mercy, and daily touch to our Catholic brothers and sisters in prison and in the military.

OUR REACH



- **Ministry to Prisoners:** In 1989 **Partners** began sending *The Word Among Us* and its Spanish counterpart free each month to prisoners. Currently, we are serving 38,000 prisoners in 1,000 penal institutions.


- **Ministry to Service Men and Women:** In December 2005 **Partners** expanded its outreach to minister to Catholics in the armed forces. Currently 10,000 service men and women at over 150 bases throughout the world receive *The Word Among Us*, including the daily Mass readings and articles on living the Christian life.

OUR 2007 GOALS

- **Ministry to Prisoners:**
To touch 47,000 Catholics in prison in the United States and Canada.

- **Ministry to Service Men and Women:**
To bring Christ's love to 13,000 Catholics in the armed services.

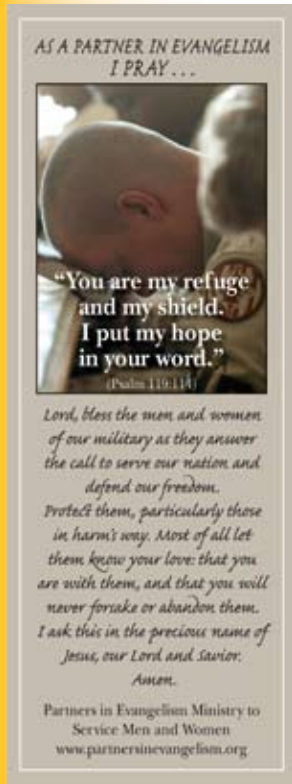
